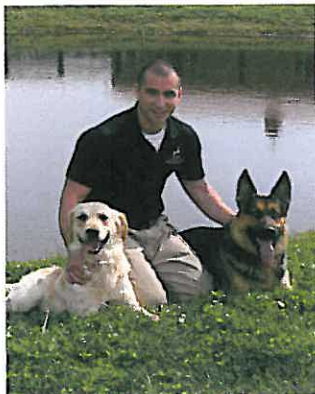
1. It is highly recommended to use a clicker and high-value treats. This small device can easily be carried with you, and once it is pressed it makes a distinctive clicking sound. This will indicate the exact behavior you want to reward. These gadgets are inexpensive and can be purchased at a variety of pet stores.
2. Take your dog on a leash, and as soon as your dog goes potty, use the clicker and reward them with a treat. This indicates to the pup that "when I go outside, good things happen. When I go inside, nothing happens." In due time, your dog will learn to go outside without reinforcement of a clicker or treat.
3. Make sure you have plenty of chew toys for your dog as well as a soft one. If you catch your dog chewing on the couch, tell them no and hand them something that is safe to chew on. Consistency is the key to success!
