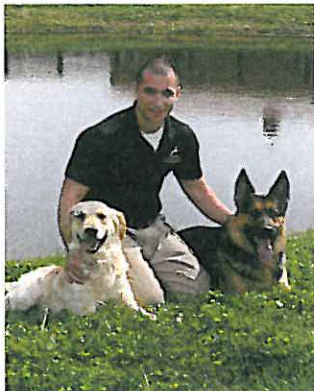
1. Make sure you establish a proper relationship with your dog and provide them with enough exercise.
2. Keep your dog off the furniture (bed, chair, couch, etc). While these areas may look comfortable for your pup, they are considered high points in the room, which in return, represent dominance.
3. Make sure your dog knows you are the one that eats first and they eat second. This will make it clear that YOU are the one in control.
4. An aggression problem will not go away by itself. Treatment is best handled by a professional behaviorist who has a lot of experience working with aggressive dogs.
